# Dear friends,

We begin July with a newly elected government and a keener awareness of a transformed political landscape in our nation. Let us offer our prayers for all the new members of parliament and for the nation's new leaders that they may be guided by wisdom, integrity and a commitment to the common good and the dignity of each person. Let us also pray for the dawn of hope in our local communities amid the many challenges that people face in their lives. The image which the Bible uses for leaders is the shepherd who keeps the flock together and safe, walking alongside them and confronting danger on their behalf. It is an image of attentive service and commitment with high expectations. It is an image that Jesus uses of himself: he is the Good Shepherd, who alone of all the leaders of the people loves his flock so much that he will give up everything to seek the lost and bring them home. Indeed, as fully human and fully divine, and through his death and resurrection, Jesus alone possesses the authority to bring humanity back to the fullness of our common vocation to serve each other in love and to face and overcome all that is harmful within us. More than this, as our Gospel today highlights, the full extent of Jesus' authority is revealed in the way he gives it away to his disciples in the name of serving God and humanity. This capacity to share power for the sake of others acts as a divine standard not simply for our elected officials but all of us. We are all given a measure of authority to serve others in our families, communities, workplaces, political institutions, and wider civic society. Let us, therefore, pray that our new Prime Minister and his government, all newly elected MPs, and we ourselves might all be inspired by Jesus and serve those entrusted to us with humility, compassion, and a dedication to their good and the good of all.
