## Dear friends,

During his sermon, Archdeacon Luke referred to Canon E of the legal Canons of the Church of England which states: churchwardens "shall discharge such duties as are by law and custom assigned to them; they shall be foremost in representing the laity and in co-operating with the incumbent; they shall use their best endeavours by example and precept to encourage the parishioners in the practice of true religion and to promote unity and peace among them. They shall also maintain order and decency in the church and churchyard, especially during the time of divine service." These words set a high standard. I have full confidence in Sam and the gifts she will bring to the role as she has already done to the life of St George's. Nevertheless, being a churchwarden is, as with anyone who seeks to follow Christ faithfully, never something we do on our own. A churchwarden serves as part of a community in which they work with others and are supported by them, even as wardens are charged to model such behaviour. We are fortunate to have a great team of deputy wardens and other volunteers to assist Sam. Together let us all build more sustainable patterns of volunteering and lay leadership to enable more people to be active in our church life and the wider community. 
