## Dear friends,

It is with joy that during the All-Age Eucharist today eight children from our parish will be baptised and eleven will receive their first communion. Baptism and Eucharist are the core sacraments by which each of us comes to belong to God within the life of the Church. By the waters of baptism, we are incorporated into the death and resurrection of Christ and become part of Christ's community, the Church. By the bread and wine of the Eucharist, what began in baptism is celebrated and deepened. We are nourished by Christ's real presence who is our real spiritual food. As we receive Christ into hearts and minds, we are remade into the body of Christ together with all those others who have been baptised and who receive communion. Indeed, through Baptism and the Eucharist, we concretely discover that it is with these others that we belong. We are family. We are friends bound together in the love of God and the love of our fellow human beings within a kingdom to which all are welcome and where the smallest are made the greatest. And so, it is only right that children should be wholeheartedly welcomed into and celebrated at the heart of this sense of belonging in their baptism and first communion. As Jesus said, "Let the little children come to me" (Matt. 19:14). What is more, another cause for celebration takes place on Wednesday this week when four older children and three adults from St George's will be confirmed by Bishop Will at Chichester Cathedral. He will anoint them with the oil of chrism and seal them with the Holy Spirit, the Spirit who will complete what was begun in their baptism, strengthen them in their faith, become their innermost confidant, and help them to live out their identity as children of God as members of the body of Christ, serving God and others in all they are and do. Let us pray for all those who will be baptised and confirmed and receive their first communion. And let us rejoice with them.
